INGEMAR OFFERS ITS SERVICES FOR THE AMERICA'S CUP IN NAPLES AND VENICE

Both events of the Americas Cup's in Italy will be served by Ingemar floating pontoons

Milan, 26 marzo 2012. After Cascais, Plymouth and San Diego the racetrack brings the America's Cup into the most prestigious Italian sites for sailing industry: to Naples from 11th till 15th April and Venice from May 12h till 20th. Ingemar will be present in both events with the modular floating pontoons, a new success for the Italian company from Milano, already established as technical sponsor of the major Italian Boat Shows and partner for important water sport events.

In Naples the regatta fields will take place in front of the promenade via Caracciolo and the Rotonda Diaz, while in Venice the catamaran teams will face each other in San Marco basin in front of the Doges Palace and in the open sea in front of the Lido.

Both in Naples and in Venice the regatta will consist of championship racing, match race and speed trials on the decks of challenging AC45, catamarans furnished with a rigid wing. For both events Ingemar floating pontoons will serve as a base for all the service boats to the regatta.

Installation of 500 linear meter of Ingemar floating pontoons to host both events is under way along the Neapolitan promenade and inside the historical Venetian Arsenal. All the pontoons have galvanized steel frames, concrete floating units with polystyrene core and tropical hardwood decking.

Ingemar's Chairman Lorenzo Isalberti commented on this new involvement of the company: *"after experiences with the Olympic Games in Athens and our support for the Louis Vuitton Cup in Sicily, Ingemar is ready to come back to the fields with the leading actors of the international sailing. We are happy to offer our contribution to the Italian events of the America's Cup; it is our reward for constant commitment to develop the yachting industry and a proof of our continuous support for water sports"*.

For over 30 years Ingemar has been designing and building pontoons and floating breakwaters worldwide and today is one of the few companies in the sector having its own independent production facilities which allows it to carry out Research and Development in order to anticipate market demands. The ISO 9001 certification for design, construction and installation testifies to its constant dedication and commitment to quality and is complemented by the SOA certification by the port sector for commissions of up to Euro 15.5 million. The company's Head Offices are in Milan and production and customer services are at Casale sul Sile in the province of Treviso.
