SUPERYACHT MARINA OF THE YEAR 2015: PORTO MONTENEGRO!

More than 3.000 voters of Yacht Harbour Association (TYHA) Gold Anchor awarded Porto Montenegro, furnished with floating structures by Ingemar Group, with the "Superyacht Marina of the year 2015" title

Milano, 25 may 2015. The ceremony of "**Marina of the Year 2015 Award**" established by **Yacht Harbour Association** has recently taken place in London. Among 84 marine rated worldwide, the first prize in the category 'Superyacht' was attributed to the Marina Porto Montenegro, where all the floating structures were supplied by Ingemar Group.

After a competitive international tender with participation of the top global players in the industry, the Italian group had been awarded the contract and since then worked on multiple supplies between 2009 and 2014 contributing to the development of the new Porto Montenegro in Tivat, UNESCO heritage site and the largest natural port in Southern Europe with access to the Adriatic Sea.

Today Porto Montenegro is equipped with the most prestigious and innovative floating structures for mooring (jetties, platforms, walkways, docks and fingers) specifically designed for the new marina and equipped with all the necessary technical equipment and service for the reception more than 650 vessels of medium and large size. In addition, 340 linear meters of concrete floating breakwaters protect the site from the waves generated by the strong local bora winds.

The 'Monte Carlo of the Adriatic' has an area of 24 hectares and was created by Peter Munk, Canadian businessman of Hungarian origin and founder of the world's largest gold mining company, together with a list of international partners, including Bernard Arnault, chairman of the "luxury-group" LVMH, the Russian steel magnate Oleg Deripaska, aluminum producer in Montenegro, Lord Jacob Rothschild and his son Nathaniel, Sandro Demijan and Anthony Munk, representing a very active New York-based private equity firm.

This new international recognition of a project that has seen the company deeply involved for such a long period brought a great satisfaction to the offices in Casale. According to President Lorenzo Isalberti: " The award puts on a highest level of the podium, together with the owners, managers and other partners in the project, also the excellence of Made in Italy and over 35 years of experience in our Group.-

For over 30 years Ingemar has been designing and building pontoons and floating breakwaters worldwide and today is one of the few companies in the sector having its own independent production facilities which allows it to carry out Research and Development in order to anticipate market demands. The ISO 9001 certification for design, construction and installation testifies to its constant dedication and commitment to quality and is complemented by the SOA certification by the port sector for commissions of up to Euro 15.5 million. The company's Head Offices are in Milan and production and customer services are at Casale sul Sile in the province of Treviso.
